

RII30120- CERTIFICATE III IN SURFACE EXTRACTION OPERATIONS (TRAINEESHIP PATHWAY)

Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of employees such as production operators in an open cut mine or quarry, who perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

Course Duration

The nominal duration of a full-time traineeship is 24 months.

Units Of Competency

Three (3) core units of competency:

- RIIWHS201D Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures
- RIIENV201D Identify and assess environmental and heritage concerns
- RIIRIS301D Apply risk management processes

Ten (10) elective units must also be chosen and be relevant to the job function. There are both licensed and non-licensed units of competency relating to high-risk work in the RII Resources and Infrastructure Industry Training Package.

Electives can be chosen from the following list of units:

- RIICOM301D Communicate information
- RIIGOV201D Comply with site work processes/procedures
- RIIMPO308E Conduct tracked dozer operations
- RIIMPO309E Conduct wheeled dozer operations
- RIIMPO310E Conduct grader operations
- RIIMPO312E Conduct scraper operations
- RIIHAN208D Perform dogging
- RIIHAN301D Operate elevating work platforms
- RIIHAN302D Conduct intermediate scaffolding operations
- RIIHAN304D Conduct slewing crane operations
- RIIHAN305D Operate a gantry or overhead crane
- RIIHAN307D Operate a vehicle loading crane

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification however students must be employed under a training contract with an employer and have selected CCT as their Supervising Registered Training Organisation (SRTO).

RPL/RCC

A recognition pathway is available for participants who can demonstrate previous relevant training and/or work experience. Participants undergo pre-assessment where evidence of prior learning is measured against the program competency standards. The RPL pathway is identified during pre-enrolment and orientation/ and in course information flyers and student handbook.

Assessment

Direct observations/practical demonstrations, written/oral questioning and third-party reports from supervisors/employers are the methods used to determine competency for each unit.

Outcome

On successful completion of the required 13 units of competency and on the job verification, participants will be eligible to receive the qualification RII30115 Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations. Trainees who exit the program after completing just a selection of competencies will be granted a Statement of Attainment for all units successfully completed.

Successful completion of nineteen (13) units of competency is made up of:

Three (3) core units, and ten (10) elective units of which:

- one (1) must be chosen from group A
- one (1) must be chosen from group B
- at least three (3) must be chosen from group C
- up to three (3) may be chosen from group D and/or group E
- up to two (2) may be chosen from Certificate II, Certificate III or Certificate IV level from this, or any other Training Package or accredited course

Pathways

RII30820 Certificate III in Civil Construction Plant Operations or RII40720 Certificate IV in Civil Construction Operations or RII40720 Certificate IV in Civil Construction.
