

RII20220 - Certificate II in Surface Extraction Operations

Course Overview

This course equips individuals with the skills and knowledge needed to begin a career in open pit mining, including roles in quarries and open-cut metalliferous mines. It offers a solid foundation for working as an operator in surface extraction operations, focusing on safety and efficiency. As a nationally recognised entry level qualification in surface extraction operations, it opens opportunities to develop as an operator and start your mining career with confidence. Ideal for entry-level operators in open-cut coal, metalliferous mines, or quarries.

Course Duration – up to 12 months

Theory and practical training and assessment delivered in classroom and on-site training facility.
