

RIIWH5205E TRAFFIC CONTROLLER TRAINING PROGRAM RENEWAL PROGRAM

Course Overview

This course is designed for individuals required to complete an approved traffic controller renewal training course to enable them to renew their traffic controller accreditation.

Course Duration

Formal Training – 4 hours approx.

Day 1 - Theory Refresher and Assessment

In addition, course participants will be required to provide evidence of Currency of Industry Practice by submitting a COIP form with supporting documentation. Assessors will verify participants' currency of industry practice. Additional assessment may be required at the discretion of the assessor. This could include practical demonstration; challenge test; oral questioning.

Informal Training

Mandatory logbook hours in the workplace.

The student must complete the minimum 20 log hours in their logbook. Students have a maximum timeframe of 3 months to complete the course.

Topics Covered

- Plan and prepare
- Control traffic
- Operate communication devices
- Clean up

Before commencing their practical work at a worksite, all students are required to:

1. produce their General Construction Induction Training (GCIT) card.
2. undertake a site-specific site induction.

Students must complete a minimum of 20 hours of supervised practical traffic control tasks on the job at various worksites which must be recorded in the approved logbook.

Pre-Requisites

Each course participant will be required to hold a current traffic controller industry authority card and evidence of currency and competency as per the currency of industry practice document requirements before completing the renewal course.

RPL/RCC

RPL cannot be used. All candidates must be trained against the TMR approved training course.

Outcome

Upon successful completion of the course the student will be issued a nationally recognised training statement of attainment for the unit RIIWH5205E Control traffic with stop-slow bat.

Pathways

RIIWHS205E is a unit from the qualification RII30820 Certificate III in Civil Construction Plant Operations.

Licensing

Traffic control accreditation must be renewed every 3 years in Queensland. To renew your accreditation refer to <https://www.tmr.qld.gov.au/business-industry/Accreditations/Traffic-Controller-Accreditation-Scheme>

Entry Requirements

CCT policy requires students to be a minimum of 18 years of age prior to enrolling and attending this course due to WHS considerations and licensing requirements. Entrants should also hold a construction white card or equivalent.

Resources Required

Students are required to wear appropriate clothing including high visibility long sleeve shirt, long pants, work boots, and hard hat during training. Machinery and equipment are supplied when training at our facility. All written material and stationery are supplied for the course. Students must provide their own food; fridges are available onsite. Tea and coffee are supplied by CCT.
